The complex has two main courtyards, a house on the ground floor with 200 square meters, and two loft-style apartments of 80 and 120 square meters, respectively.






















Outside the house, there is a shop selling ceramic pots, iron furniture, and wrought iron made by the decorator Jesús Gómez.
