Casa Palacio 29 is a historic building in the center of Seville, which was the former United States Pavilion of the 1929 Universal Exhibition.

A very unique palace house, completely renovated, where work meetings, product presentations, institutional events, and business gatherings can take place.





The permanent exhibition on its ground floor is integrated with the event, coexisting with the artists who are part of its permanent or temporary collection.

As a location situated in the center of Seville, it has different rooms for each type of event, which can be customized according to the event's needs.





Casa Palacio 29 is a venue with a marked artistic and avant-garde character that firmly establishes it within the range of spaces in Seville for the promotion of top-tier business actions and events.

The capacities of the rooms are as follows:

PATIO: 175-200Ppax in cocktail-style arrangement

MAIN ROOM:

- 110pax in theatre-style arrangement

- 30pax in U-style arrangement

- 80pax in banquet-style arrangement

MEETING ROOM: 14pax in theatre-style arrangement
