Located 15 minutes away from Seville, it is a ranch with livestock, covering an area of 3000 hectares, dedicated to breeding Pure Spanish horses and beef and dairy cattle among many other activities. The origin of the buildings is a 17th-century Jerónimos Convent and was respectfully restored.



This estate is the best example of preserved rural architecture without adaptations for events. It still retains part of its agricultural function, making it an authentic space where the client will perceive a unique experience. The event space consists of: a courtyard, an old winery, and a garden. Spaces with a special charm, away from the tourist circuit, and immersed in the rural and profound Andalusia that a certain clientele appreciates.



This estate has an ancient history, as it was once settled by an Arab hamlet.

After the Christian conquest, it was renamed with its current name and constituted until a few decades ago a nucleus of population that reached almost a hundred inhabitants.
