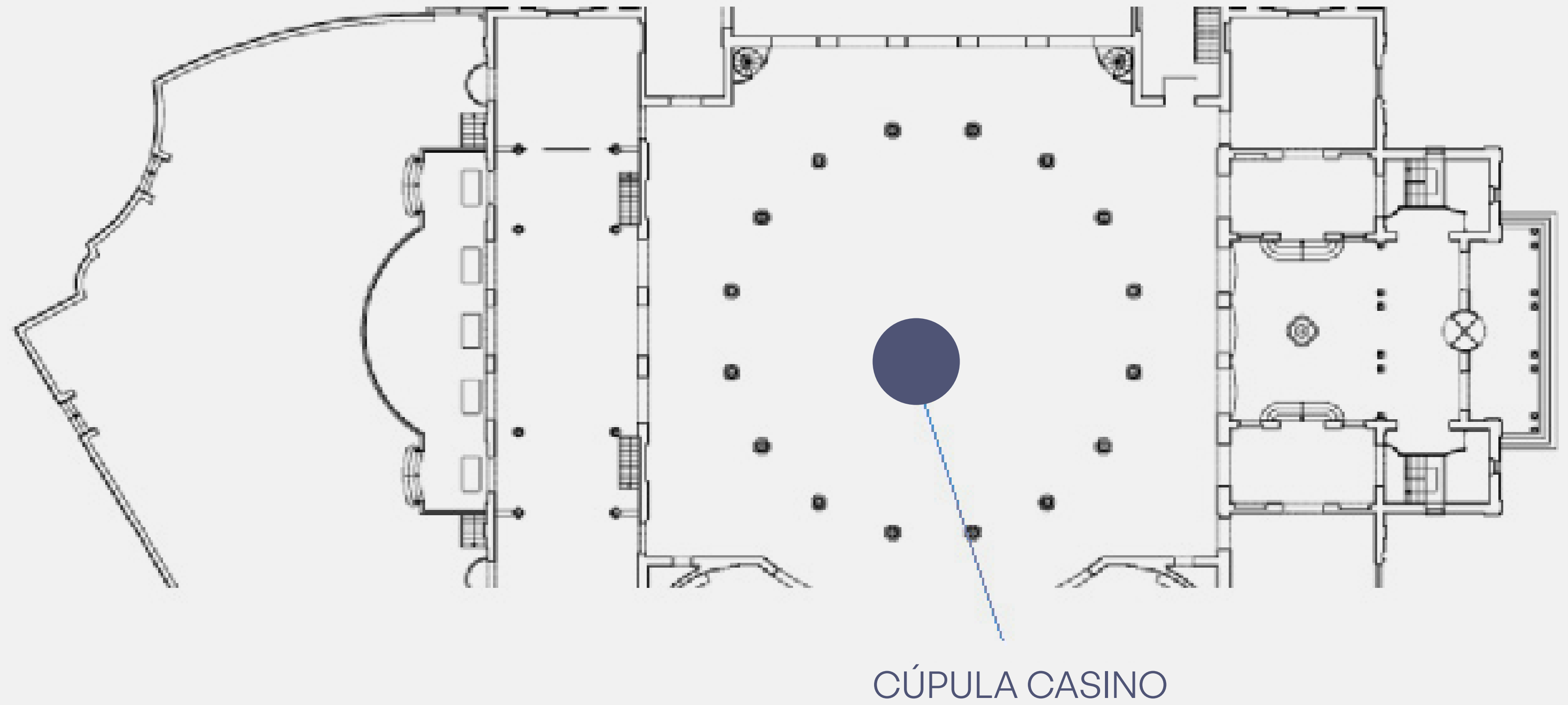


Cúpula Casino de la Exposición de Sevilla
