Espacio Santa Ana is located at Triana, one of the most astonishing and renowned neighborhoods in town, characterized by its history, character, architecture, and ceramics. This venue is, nothing less, one of the factories where those typically Triana tiles were made.





In the brick and tile factory conceived by Aníbal González, the architect of the Plaza de España, were crafted and now adorn its walls. Recently, it underwent a renovation and refurbishment to become what it is today: a venue where you can admire the beauty of Sevillian pottery while hosting various events.

Its structure and dimensions are ideal for product and service presentations, corporate meetings, conferences, awards ceremonies or meetings.

The maximum capacity of the space is 120 people distributed across 3 areas. Two outdoor patios can accommodate up to 70 guests, and an indoor room is suitable for exhibitions, meetings, or workshops.







The outdoor area enjoys excellent lighting, ideal for both daytime and nighttime events, surrounded by the old ceramic kilns that the factory had and its unique pottery decoration. Theater-style presentations, cocktails, and banquets will be perfect in these classic courtyards.
