



Casa Fígaro, dating back to the 15th century, is a palace located in the city of Seville. The building is a combination of Italian Renaissance and Spanish Mudéjar styles, considered a prototype of an Andalusian palace.

Located in the monumental area of the old town of Seville, this house can host events throughout the year, thanks to a system that allows its courtyards to be closed off and isolated from the outside when necessary.

# Spaces and Capacities

The venue offers a main Renaissance courtyard with Mudéjar decoration where up to 400 people can gather. This courtyard features a fountain and statues of the god Palas.

You can also enjoy a dining room for 90 guests, and the chapel can accommodate up to 50. Additionally, Casa Fígaro has a fresco hall for 120 people, a small room for 30, and stables for 250 summer seats.






