

Sala Antiquarium

The Antiquarium space was created during the construction of the Metropol Parasol building in Seville. It is an underground space of 4,500 square meters composed of a fish salting factory from the 1st century and several villas with mosaics from the 2nd, 3rd, and 5th centuries of the Roman period, a 6th-century house from the Visigothic period, and a 13th-century house from Islamic civilization. Factory 37 is a multi-purpose venue of about 700 square meters, with complementary or independent access and operation of its zones. It can host any type of event: from presentations to communication activities. It offers a capacity of 70 people in cocktail format in the main hall. This unique venue, recently renovated and refurbished, allows it to host any type of event. Its interior architecture has been transformed into a modern space, where each room is adorned with handcrafted corten steel sculptures, making it a highly exclusive space.





The museum is enclosed by a glass membrane of 1,100 square meters that wraps around the entire space and interacts with the ruins by suspending hanging walls and lanterns of light that, along with the rest of the elements, allow for the reconstruction of the sensations of the spaces in which our ancestors lived.



The main access to the different spaces of the Antiquarium site is materialized through a glass floor, from where the remains that extend in the large archaeological hall can be glimpsed. This walk will take place through 400 square meters of walkways.



The “Sala Antiquarium” is a multi-purpose area of about 700 square meters with complementary or independent access and operation of the archaeological area.

It can host a wide variety of events, from presentations to communication activities.

It is equipped with the latest audiovisual technology, independent services, designer furniture, and screens.
