






The initial project addressed its subsequent reuse as a warehouse.
















This set of attached warehouses forms the "Docks of the Port of Seville." The facade and characteristic elements of the inside composition are distinctive at both the spatial and structural levels.

Almacén 19 has done a comprehensive transformation of it technical provision with a major remodelling to modernize its uses, enabling it to host innovative events from various sectors. It features a distinct space with a capacity for 450 attendees. A small auditorium with a stage and tiered seating. It has a vast hall where various parallel activities such as exhibitions, receptions, and welcoming events, or even catering services associated with any type of event, can be organized.












